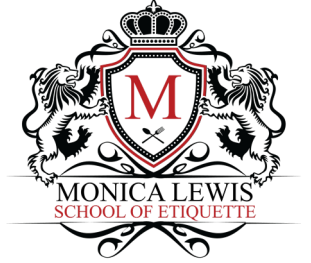
FAQs

Where is the drop-off location, and what time should we arrive?

Retreat check-in will begin at 12noon The MISS Academy, 1111 Uptown Park, Ste. 12, Houston, TX 77056. A Monica Lewis School of Etiquette rep will verify the contact & registration for each camper. Upon arrival we will load all luggage and provide a general orientation. We will depart from the academy at 1:00pm.

What to pack?

- In a Trunk (no taller than 16") or Large Duffle Bag:
- BED LINENS: Single sheet set and a blanket, or twin-size fitted sheet.
- Pillow and Pillowcase
- Bath towel and washcloth (2 sets)
- Swimsuit (girls need a one-piece or tankini that covers the midriff)
- Swim towel
- TOILETRIES: soap (liquid bath soap is recommended), shampoo/conditioner, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, powder, etc.
- Insect repellent
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Shower shoes (flip-flops work well)
- Clothing for 3 days & 3 nights is necessary, as well as an extra set.
 - Shorts (at least 3 inch inseam)
 - Shirts (loose fitting and light colors for the heat)
 - Undergarments
 - Socks (to ankle or above), 2 pair per day, please!
 - 1 pair of long pants
 - 2 sets of pajamas
- 1 pair of tennis shoes. Campers MAY NOT wear Crocs or sandals.
 - Water shoes or slides for water events
- Sunscreen
- (1) Youth Spinning Reel and Fishing Rod Combo with line (www.walmart.com has the best) we will supply the bait
- Rain gear – poncho or rain jacket, boots, umbrella, etc. (weather applicable)

Is my registration transferrable or refundable?

Due to the limited number of spots in the retreat, the enrollment is non-refundable. Your registration purchase is your registration in the class. The ticket fee includes the snack, class materials and a graduate certificate for your child. If another spot should open on a different date, we may be able to move your registration but cannot guarantee the transfer.

What kind of food will you serve?

How are beds and logging assigned?
